

Why Should You Enroll in Both DSCC and All Kids Programs?

- The DSCC and All Kids programs will work together to help your family and child receive the special services he or she may need.
- All Kids can help pay for medical care, including mental health services, for all chronic health conditions. All Kids also provides assistance with routine and preventive health and dental care.
- DSCC will be able to provide additional help to pay for specialty care for certain medical conditions which are chronic and treatable. DSCC will help families coordinate the needed medical care with their providers. DSCC will also assist families to use the available resources to help pay for that care.

Services Available from All Kids

- Prenatal care
- Well-child and well-baby visits
- Immunizations and prescription medicines
- Physician visits (both routine and specialty)
- Hospitalization and emergency services
- Medical equipment and supplies
- Vision
- Physical/occupational/speech therapies
- Dental care
- Mental health and substance abuse services

All Kids eligibility applies to children from birth to 19 years of age, plus pregnant moms.

Why DSCC?

Services Available from DSCC

- Specialized medical equipment and supplies
- Selected specialized medical care that is not a benefit of All Kids
- Staff who will coordinate care for medically eligible children with special health care needs, regardless of family income. Care coordination means helping families:
 - Understand their child's medical care and treatment,
 - Arrange medical care with qualified health care providers,
 - Access other community/agency programs,
 - Understand and maximize the use of their private insurance or All Kids benefits.

DSCC eligibility applies to medically-eligible children from birth up to the age of 21 years.
